

How to use the Pulse Secure client to connect to UConn resources

Install and Configure Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X or Windows machines

First you will need to download, install and configure the client.

Open a web browser and go to:

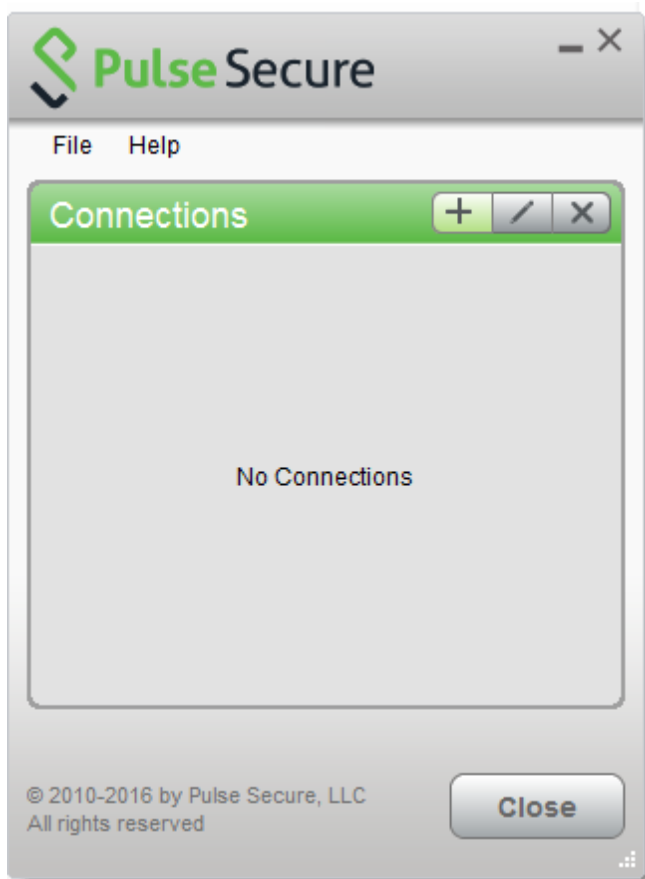
Use the link of 'Accessing the UConn Network Through a VPN Client'.

Step 1: Download the installer that is appropriate to your operating system. Click the link on the webpage.

Step 2: Run the downloaded installer.

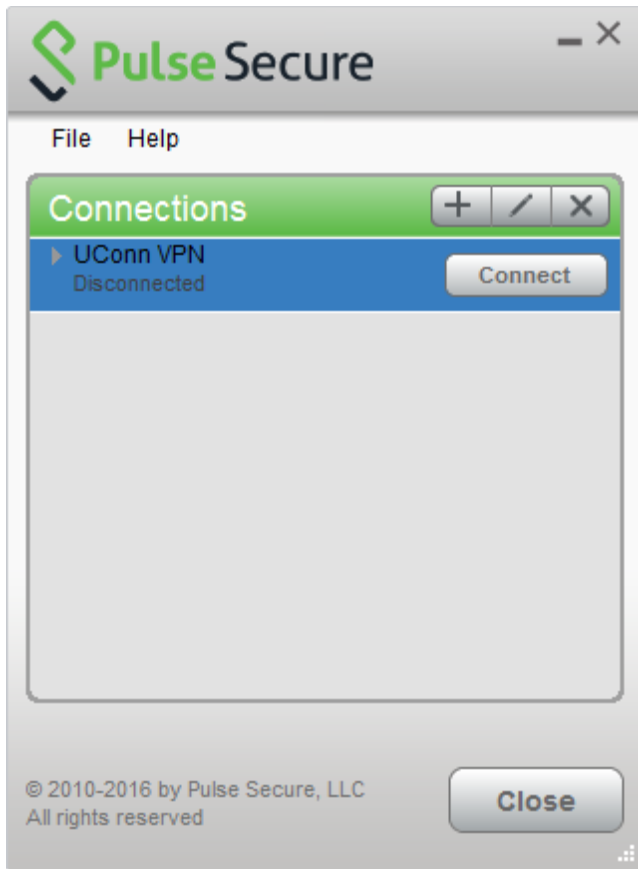
Step 3: configure the client

Launch the now-installed application.

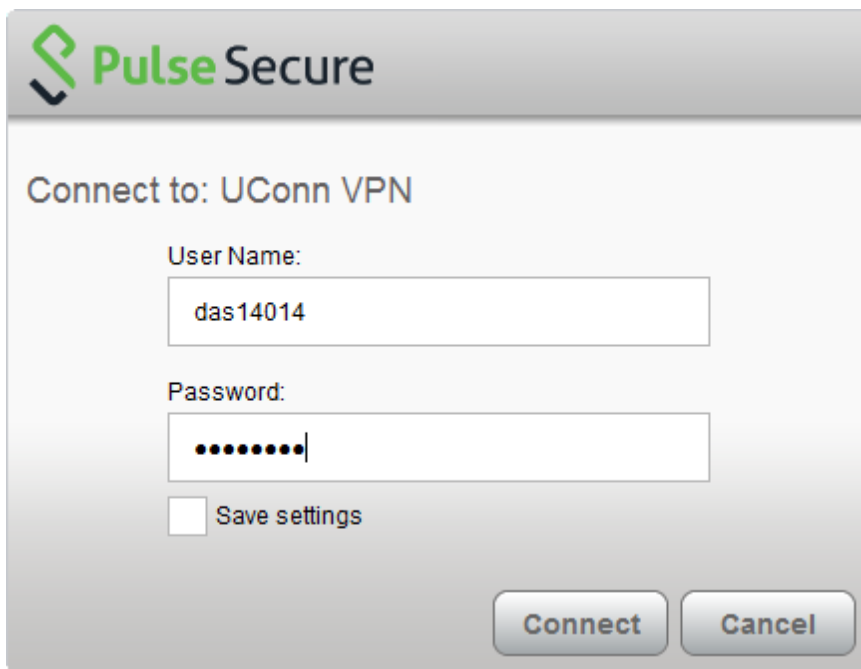


Click the '+' button to add a new connection and enter **vpn.uconn.edu** for the Server URL and "**UConn VPN**" for the Name. If 'Type' is requested, choose the option that lists SSL-VPN.

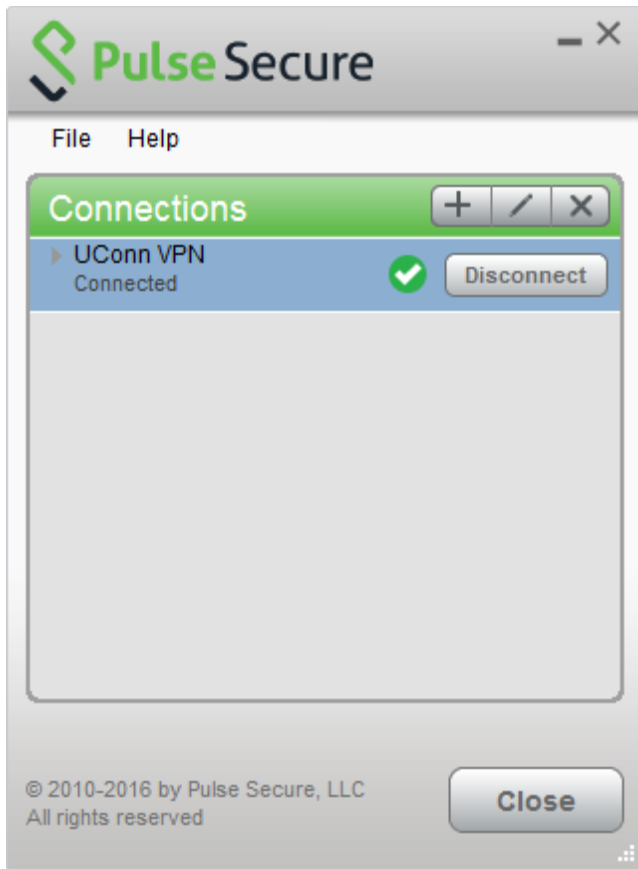
Click Add.



Now click Connect, and enter your NetID and password into the form,



click the Connect button again.



You should now be successfully connected and see the green check mark.

Whenever you need to connect to UConn resources such as the network "Q drive" you will need to launch the Pulse Secure application, press Connect and supply your NetID and password.

When you are done with your session press the Disconnect button in the Pulse Secure application.
